### Boating Rules

1. Tennessee state law requires the operator of a watercraft to be 13 years old or above.
2. When entering the Lake, do so in a counter clockwise direction.
3. Observe the 5 mph **NO WAKE ZONE**. **All Coves are NO WAKE/IDLE SPEED**.
4. Do not anchor to buoys.
5. When water skiing, observe the following:  
Skiing is permitted during daylight hours only.  
Vessels towing skiers must be equipped with a 170-degree wide-angle rearview Mirror or have a person on board 13 years or older, other than the vessel operator to observe the progress of the skier(s).  
Skiers must wear a life jacket.  
Observe courtesy and rules of the road to other boaters and property owners.
6. Boats left in the Lake overnight must be tied up to a personal dock or at a marina slip (which has been rented for the year).
7. The boat ramp is for loading and unloading only. Do not leave a vehicle unattended on the ramp. There is no fishing or swimming from the boat ramp.
8. The beach is off limits to boats. The roped off area is for swimming only.

### Personal watercraft-Jet Ski's

1. Operators of Jet Ski's must wear a life jacket at all times.
2. Jet Ski's may be operated between sunrise and sunset on the main Lake only.
3. Jumping the wake of another boat is prohibited within 100 feet.
4. A fully charged fire extinguisher must be on board and operators must be 13 years or older.
5. Observe **NO WAKE / IDLE SPEED** areas.
6. Do not ski or Jet Ski in coves, use the Main Lake only.

### FISHING

1. No fishing with nets, trotlines, yoyo's, electrical shocking devices, chemicals, fish baskets or any explosives.
2. Jug fishing is allowed after sunset until sunup. Jugs must be marked with the Owner's name and lot number.
3. Fishing from the Marina is allowed. No swimming and diving.
4. Fishing is not allowed anywhere near the beach area.
